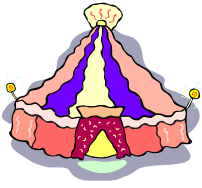

Medicare and the New Health Care Law

The recently enacted Affordable Care Act passed by Congress and signed into law by the President in 2010 includes two key provisions relating to the Original Medicare prevention benefits beginning in 2011.

- 1. Medicare now covers the cost of an annual wellness visit with your doctor.**
 - The "Welcome to Medicare" physical exam helps you and your doctor develop a personalized plan to prevent disease, improve your health, and help you stay well.**

- 2. Medicare beneficiaries no longer have to pay any out of pocket costs for most preventive services.**
 - Health care to prevent illness or detect it at an early stage, when treatment is most likely to work best.**

Other important information to be aware of is the Medicare Savings Program and Extra Help Program.

Medicare Savings Program reimburses you your Medicare Part B Premium each month if your monthly income is less than \$1219 for a single individual and less than \$1640 for a married couple. No resource limits apply.

Extra Help Program is also known as the Low Income Subsidy. This program pays your Medicare drug plan's monthly premium, any yearly deductible, coinsurance and copayments, if your monthly income is less than \$1353 and resources less than \$12,500 for a single individual and monthly income less than \$1821 and resources less than \$25,010 for a married couple.

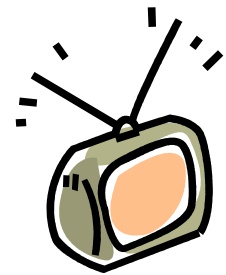

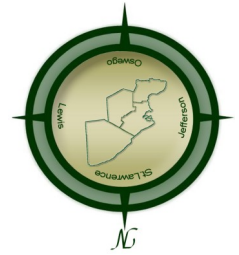

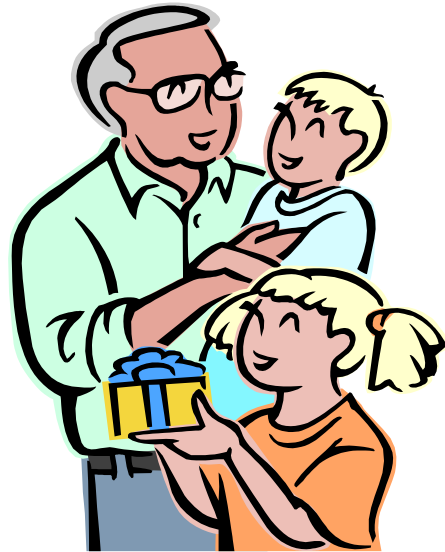
