

iDevice Users

Before we begin, things to consider...

- This is a set of steps iDevice users will need to complete **before** the **audiobooks tutorial**.
- These steps deal with the transfer of WMA files to an iDevice. Mac computers do not support the WMA file format. Thus, these steps only apply to **Windows users**.
- If you haven't yet, you will need to create an **Apple ID** that is associated with both your iDevice and the copy of iTunes you've installed to the computer (*Most iDevice users will have already completed this step*).



iDevice Objectives

- 1) Set up the **AAC import settings**.
- 2) Set your iDevice to **Manually manage music**.

To start, you will need **iTunes 9.1** or newer. You can get it from <http://www.apple.com/itunes/> and clicking the '**Download Now**' button.

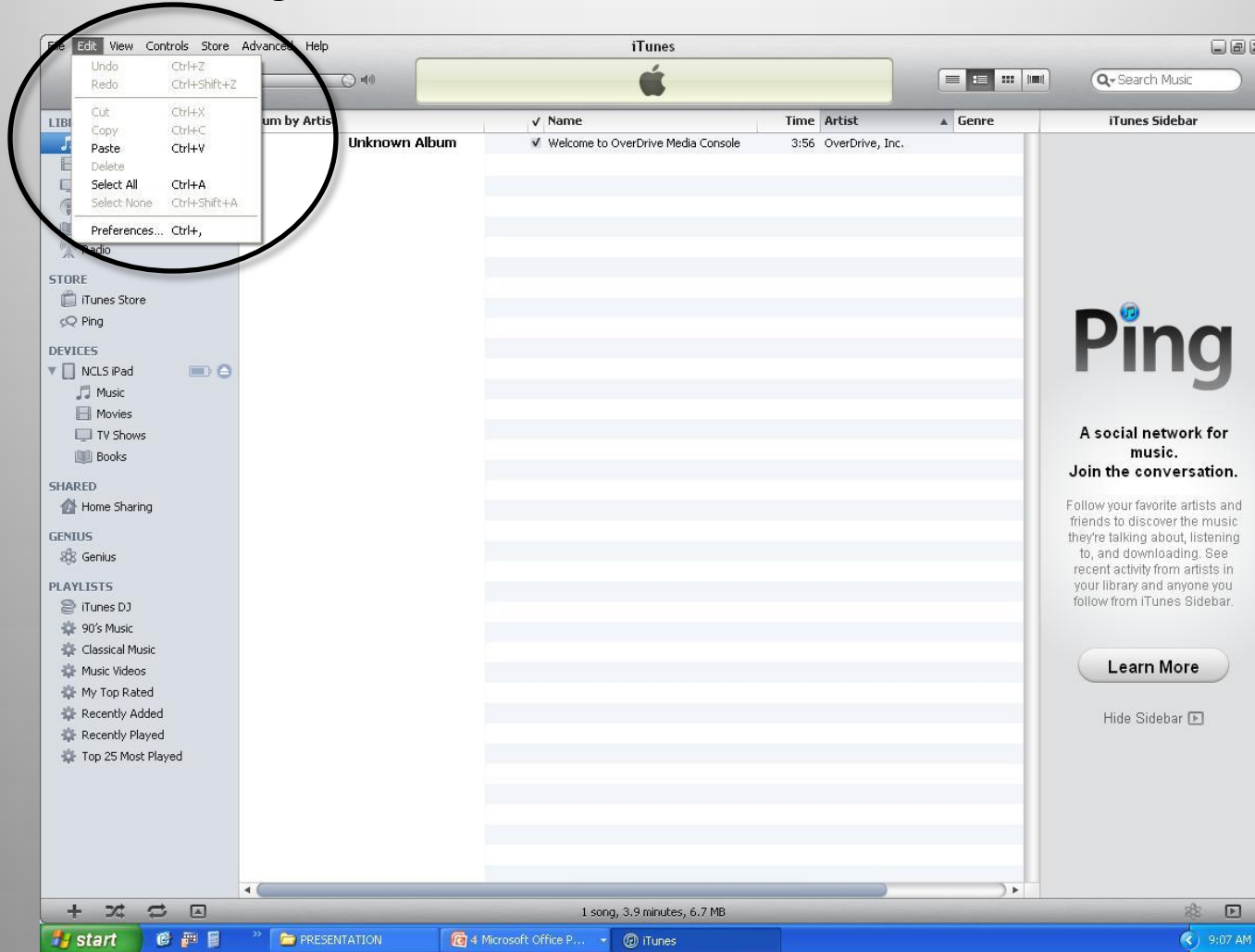

AAC Import Settings

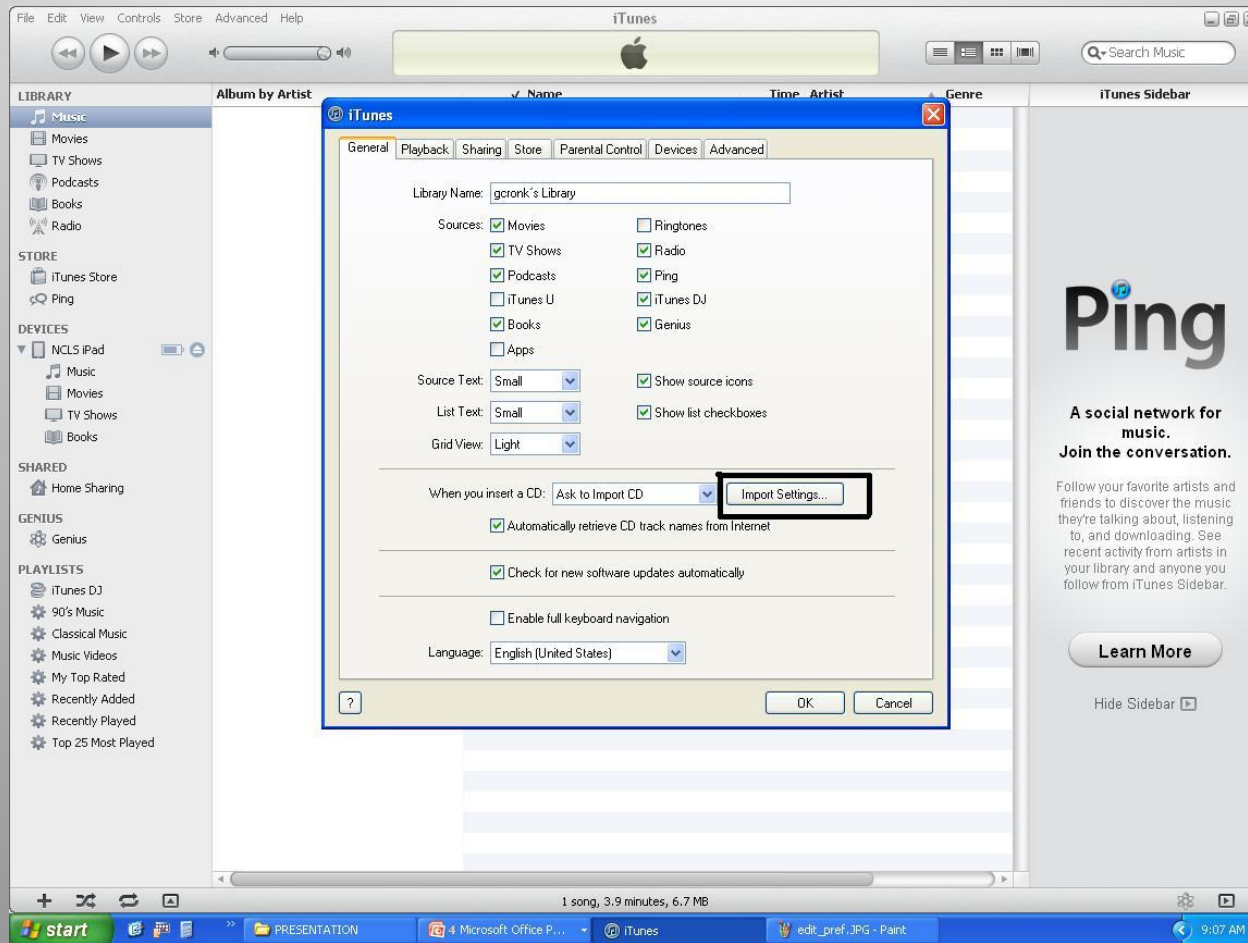
To set up the AAC Import Settings:

- In iTunes, go to **Edit** → **Preferences**.



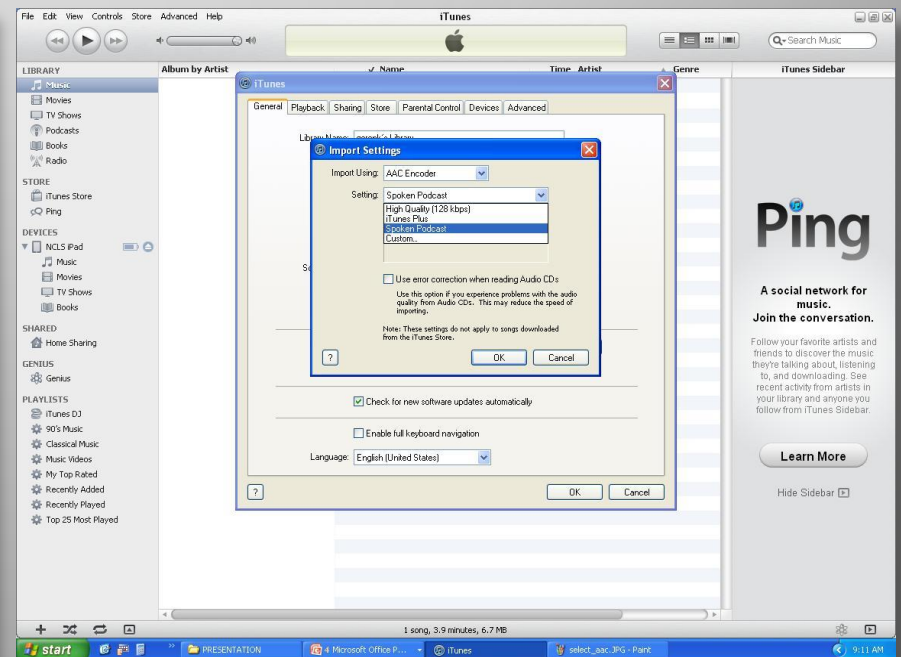
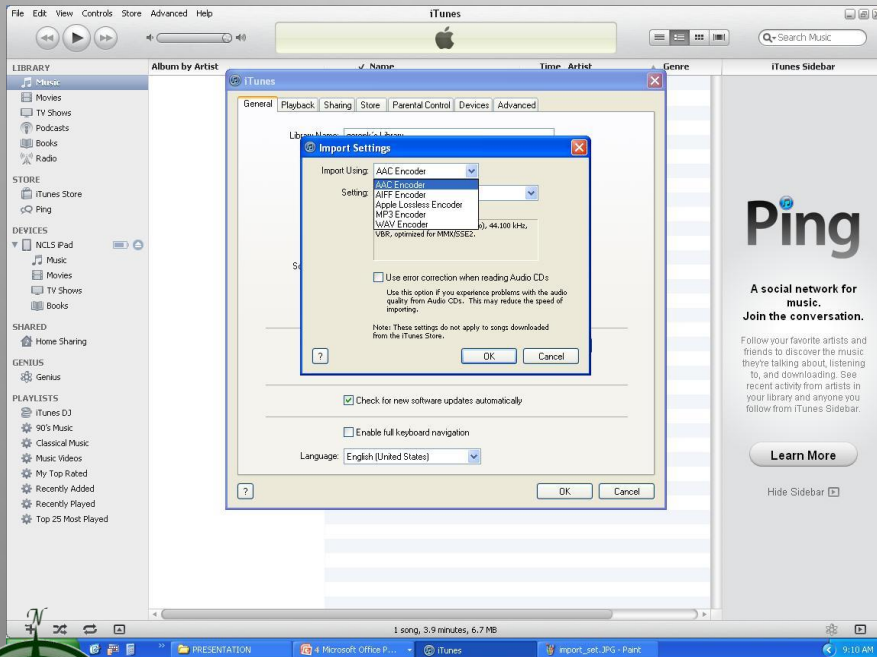
AAC Import Settings...

- The iTunes Preferences dialog box is displayed.
- Click the 'Import Settings...' button.
- The 'Import Settings' dialog box is displayed.



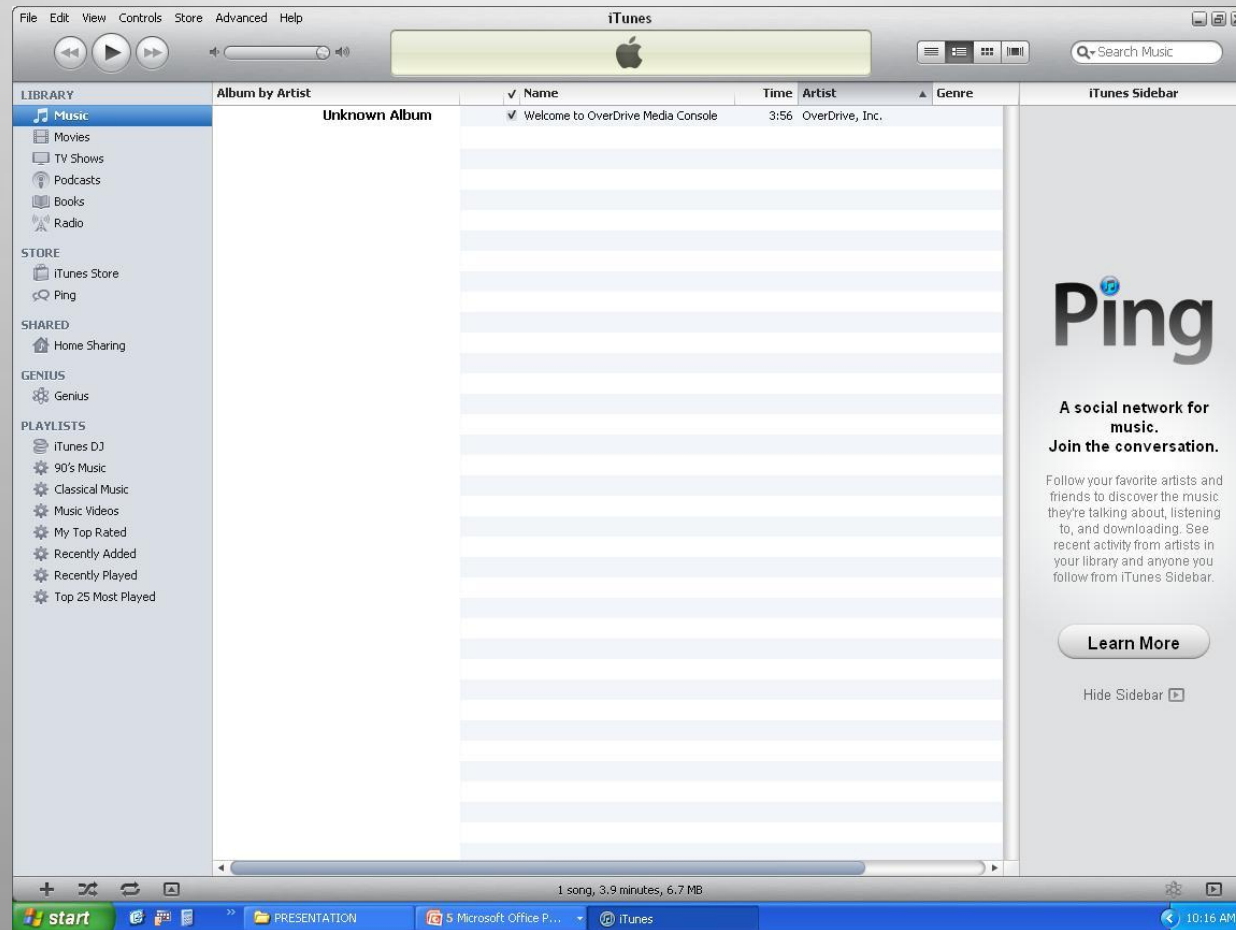
AAC Import Settings...

- In the 'Import Using' field, select option 'AAC Encoder'.
- In the 'Setting' field, select 'Spoken Podcast'.



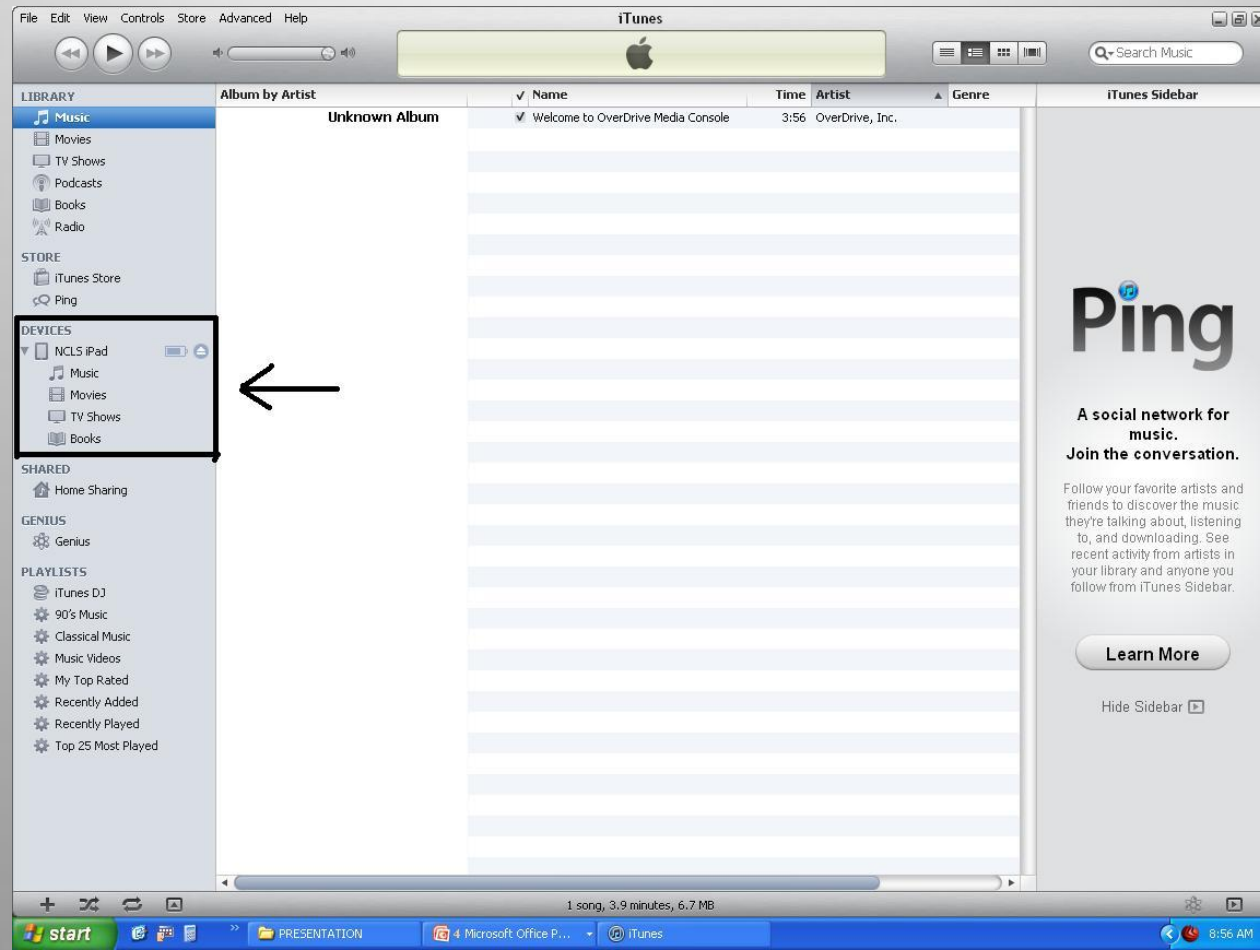
AAC Import Settings...

- Click the 'OK' button to apply your changes and close the 'Import Settings' dialog box.
- Click the 'OK' button to close the iTunes Preferences dialog box.
- If you want, after the transfer is complete, you can return to iTunes and restore the original settings.



Manually Manage Music

- **Connect** your Apple device to your computer.
- Open iTunes.
- In iTunes, locate the device in the left vertical navigation panel (under heading '**DEVICES**'), and click the device.



Manually Manage Music...

- The **'Summary'** screen should display
- If it is not already checked, place a checkmark next to the option **'Manually manage music...'**



Manually Manage Music...

- The iTunes **'Summary'** screen refreshes, and the changes are saved.
- Close iTunes.
