Jefferson County

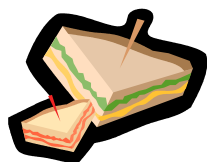

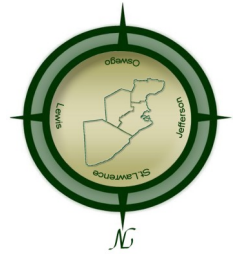
